4. Counsel should ensure that the joint practice note filed shall address all the requirements detailed in paragraph 154 of the judge president's revised consolidated directive 2 of 2022. Should they join practice note not be filed, the parties must each file a separate practice note and may indicate why a joint practice note could not be filed. The practice note must indicate under which section the relevant papers are to be found on case lines, which must be read.
5. Parties are requested to file a chronology simultaneously with the practice note.

6. Parties are requested to e-mail any proposed draft orders in Word format to [OMolopa@judiciary.org.za](mailto:OMolopa@judiciary.org.za) at least a day before a particular matter is to be heard and must be uploaded on case lines. Parties are requested to bring a hard copy of the proposed draft order to court.
7. Where matters are to be removed, postponed or have become settled, the parties must e-mail Opulent Molopa without delay at [OMolopa@judiciary.org.za](mailto:OMolopa@judiciary.org.za).
8. Introductions may be attended to in chambers on the day of the allocation before commencement of the relevant hearing as allocated.
9. Please be advised that it is not protocol to contact a Judge personally, either by way of an e-mail or a phone call.
10. All matters **will be dealt with in OPEN COURT;** and Court will start at 10H00.
